Your role

- Supporting due diligence work and preparation related to investment terms and agreements

In addition, you will support process-related workflows, including:

- Managing monthly updates of investment reports
- Assisting with the development of internal workflows when needed
- Supporting internal process projects when needed

The workload will be approximately 15-20 hours per week, with flexibility to accommodate your studies.

- Are pursuing a degree in engineering, natural sciences, computer science, business, economics, or a related field, preferably with at least one year remaining in your studies
- Are curious about startups, technology, innovation, and investment
- Enjoy analytical work and learning about new sectors and technologies
- Can communicate clear and thoughtful perspectives based on sound assessment
- Are structured, detail-oriented, and motivated by contributing to a collaborative team
